Schoeller Allibert: Schoeller Group denies intention to sell

Schoeller Group (Pullach) speaking to KI Group and Plasteurope.com has denied any intention to sell participations in Schoeller Allibert (Hoofddorp / Niederlande). The actual announcement by „Reuters“ news agency referring to a search for a buyer is not correct. Schoeller Allibert remains the key business of the traditional family business Group, holding different subsidiaries and Joint Ventures in the segments of packaging solutions, logistics and communication technology as well as managing a portfolio of direct investments.

Martin Schoeller, Managing Director of Schoeller Holding states that there is no intention to sell shares in the company. To finance the continuous growth of the former Schoeller Plast Group repeatedly corporate enterprises have been invited to co-invest. During the last 20 years among others competitors like Berolina, Wavin, Arca and Allibert were taken over. Further acquisitions may be possible in future.
